



As a Pathfinder school, parents and carers have access to regular Citizen Advice Bureau Clinics.

Our CAB worker will be providing a regular clinic at school each term for parents.

Support includes:

- helping you to be certain you're claiming all the benefits you're entitled to
- helping you fill in the application forms such as PIP & DLA (including applying for small and charitable grants)
- helping to submit challenges, reviews and appeals to the relevant benefit service
- providing benefit checks and 'better off' calculations
- helping with explaining the criteria of benefits while you are studying
- helping explain what you might be entitled to while you are not studying or if temporary absent from studies
- helping with understanding managed migration over to Universal Credit (UC), including explaining how much you may be entitled to on UC & how UC works; as well applying for UC before your Tax Credit deadline
- They can also signpost you to their debt advice team if this is needed

These surgeries are open to every family from either Junior or Infant School and meetings will last 30 minutes.
